The Captain Tag Veal Memorial Aviation Fund was established in 1988 to help Eastern develop an aviation education program for Kentucky's aspiring pilots. It honors the memory of Leslie Gordon "Tag" Veal. To be eligible for the award, a student must be a full-time student majoring in aviation, have at least a 3.0 GPA, possess an FAA private pilot license, desire a career in aviation and submit an essay identifying their career goals.

The Patricia Eidson Memorial Scholarship is given annually to an outstanding female aviation major. The scholarship honors the memory of Patricia Eidson daughter of Ralph and Mary Eidson of Richmond. To be eligible the student must have completed a minimum of 60 academic hours, Hold an FAA private pilot license, be a declared aviation major and have a minimum overall 3.00 GPA, have demonstrated a strong desire to pursue a career in commercial aviation and submit an essay on why they wish to pursue a career in aviation.

The H. Lee Moore, Jr. Aviation Scholarship is an endowed scholarship fund established at Eastern Kentucky University to help professional pilot majors finance their education in the state's only university-based, bachelor's degree aviation program. The scholarship recognizes Harold Lee Moore, Jr., Burgin, who died in a plane crash in 1992. To be eligible for this award a student must have a minimum overall 3.00 GPA, hold a private pilot license, be a declared aviation major, submit an essay on why they wish to pursue a career in aviation and priority will be given to Kentucky residents and children of postal service.
